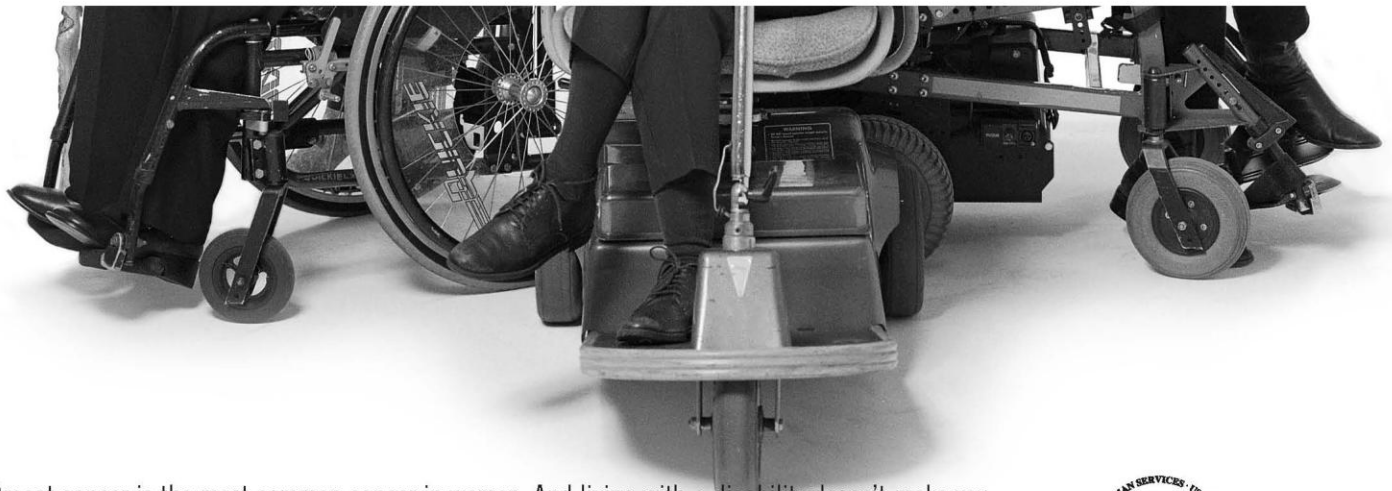




# BREAST CANCER AFFECTS ALL OF US.
