- **Submit** a recommendation letter from your program director, which includes a statement that you have their approval to attend the 2019 ASRT Educational Symposium and Annual Governance and House of Delegates Meeting, June 20-23, 2019 in Orlando, Florida.

Winners will be notified by OSRT in January 2019. Information and correspondence from ASRT will begin in February 2019. Up to two student OSRT members will be selected to participate. *Those selected may be required to complete a short on-line application for the ASRT.*

If chosen as one of the OSRT student representatives to the ASRT Student Leadership Development Program the recipient will be asked to do one of the following: Write a brief article for the OSRT website/newsletter about their experience as a participant in the Student Leadership Development Program. Attend the OSRT Annual Conference on **April** 12-13, 2019 and volunteer for 4 hours at the annual conference; or attend two meetings, one OSRT Board meeting and one Student Action Committee meeting prior to attending the ASRT Student Leadership Development Program.

This contest is only open to participants who submit original essays that they have personally created or those who have been selected by their ASRT affiliate society. Submissions must be in English.

Each participant may submit only one entry. Up to two applicants per affiliate shall be selected as winners and notified in January 2019. It is the sole discretion of OSRT and ASRT to accept or reject any submission. OSRT and ASRT's decisions as to the administration, methodology of the 2019 ASRT Student Leadership Development Program and the selection of the winners are final.

In exchange for acceptance as a participant in the 2019 ASRT Student Leadership Development Program, each recipient agrees to assign to OSRT and ASRT, upon request, all copyright, trademark and other intellectual property rights in his/her winning essay to ASRT, 15000 Central Ave. SE, Albuquerque, NM 87123.

Entry participants release OSRT and ASRT and its directors, officers, partners, employees and agents from any and all liability with respect to participation in the 2019 ASRT Student Leadership Development Program and participation in, and travel to or from, the 2019 ASRT Student Leadership Development Program.
